



Archaeologist Sub-Contractors

Tardis Archaeology are currently taking applications to form our Sub-Contractor Panel from both junior and senior archaeologists. Junior archaeologists would work as assistants, whilst senior archaeologists would work as Supervisors. It is anticipated that successful panel members will be regularly offered sub-contracting work. Remuneration is based on qualifications and experience.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Bachelor in Australian (Aboriginal and/or historic) Archaeology – Honours (minimum)
- Experience working on Australian Aboriginal and/or historic archaeology and cultural heritage projects;
- Understanding and experience with relevant Victorian and New South Wales heritage legislation;
- Able to work unsupervised (for senior archaeologists);
- Ability to work well in a team environment;
- Be proactive;
- Excellent problem solving and communication skills;
- Competence with technology, e.g. using DGPS;
- Have a vehicle & drivers license(4WD preferred);
- Have complete set of field equipment suitable for undertaken test or small scale excavations; and
- Have current First Aid Training.

Minimum Insurance Policy Cover

Due to the nature of the work as a sub-contractor you will be required to have the following insurance policy covers to be considered as a candidate.

- Public Liability \$10 million;
- Workcover or Accident/Injury; and
- Vehicle Insurance (Comprehensive).
